Archbishop of Białystok celebrates Divine Liturgy and Consecration at renovated Church

Initially serving as a cemetery chapel until 1982, it was subsequently elevated to a parish church following the establishment of a new parish in Białystok by the decree of then-Bishop Sawa of Białystok and Gdańsk.
