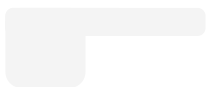
## Archbishop Makarios of Australia: “The Church and Christ give meaning to our lives”



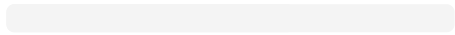
