Palm Sunday was celebrated by Metropolitan of Ireland in Nafplio



His Eminence Metropolitan lakovos of Ireland presided over the Hierarchical Divine Liturgy at the Parish Church of Saint Anastasios in Nafplio on Palm Sunday, 28 April 2024.
