## Patriarch Kirill conveys words of support and his blessing to UOC believers

The head of the Russian Orthodox Church supported the faithful of the UOC in the path they chose.

"The only correct way is to be together with the Church of the Lord and God, which He established with His blood! With a genuine church! Not with a quasi-church, not with an organization calling itself "the church", but with the real Body of Christ! And then communion in this Body of Christ with each other, especially with the Lord Himself, will strengthen us and help us overcome difficulties, which, unfortunately, pave in abundance the historical path of my beloved Ukraine today. But we believe that the night will pass and the day will come. God bless you all!" Patriarch Kirill emphasized.
