On the next day, Tuesday, 11 June 2024, His All-Holiness Ecumenical Patriarch

Bartholomew will officiate from the throne during the Divine Liturgy of the feast day which will take place at the Venerable Patriarchal Church at the Phanar, where he will be joined by the Holy Hierarchs from Constantinople and those coming from abroad.

After the dismissal of the Divine Liturgy, the Ecumenical Patriarch will be addressed by the first in order of the Holy Hierarchs, His Eminence Elder Metropolitan Emmanuel of Chalcedon, and His All-Holiness will duly respond to the wishes and address.
