Cambridge Institute for Orthodox Christian Studies marks 25th anniversary

The anniversary events, planned since the beginning of the year, will commence on June 26 with a reception for IOCS donors at Westminster Abbey.

The next anniversary event, titled "Orthodox Day," will take place on August 3 at the Southpark Cathedral in London and will be dedicated to promoting the Institute.

In the second half of the year, the Institute for Orthodox Christian Studies in Cambridge will organize a day dedicated to alumni and a fundraising concert.
