"Due to this relationship, the provision of scholarships and the hosting of Romanian Orthodox theologians continued. The ties with the Romanian Orthodox Church continued with the arrival of many Romanians in the West, some of whom settled in Italy, where we offered them hospitality, churches, and places to pray.
