2024 National YAL Conference Concludes, Celebrating Unity in Christ



New York, NY - The Greek Orthodox Archdiocese Department of Youth and Young Adult Ministries (Y2AM) is overjoyed to announce the triumphant conclusion of the 2024 National Young Adult League (YAL) Conference, held July 3-7, 2024 at The Westin Gaslamp Quarter in beautiful San Diego, California. With the blessing of His Eminence Archbishop Elpidophoros of America and the gracious hosting by His Eminence Metropolitan Gerasimos and the Metropolis of San Francisco, the Conference successfully united young adults from across the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America under the inspiring theme "UNIFY." This year's Conference, coinciding with the 47th Biennial Clergy Laity Congress and National Philoptochos Biennial Convention, embraced the theme "In Christ, We Are One" (Romans 12:4-5).
