## 300,000+ Believers participate in All-Ukrainian Cross Procession (+ VIDEO)



On the eve of the feast of the Baptism of Rus', the much-anticipated All-Ukrainian Cross Procession was held. After <u>a moleben</u>, over 300,000 believers walked on foot over 2 miles from <u>St. Vladimir's</u> Hill to the Kiev Caves Lavra to celebrate the <u>Baptism of Rus'</u>. On July 28, after the festal Liturgy, three new saints were glorified as shown in this beautiful service.

The Ukrainian Orthodox Church prepared <u>this beautiful time-lapse</u> to demonstrate just how magnificent this wonderful procession was.

The schismatics also conducted their cross processions, two in fact, as "Honorary Patriarch" Philaret, being in a mini-schism from the OCU, <u>staged his own procession</u> with <u>around 300 people</u>, separate from his former protege, the OCU "Primate" Epiphany.

As was true with <u>last year's processions</u>, the canonical procession far outnumbered the schismatics' procession, demonstrating the overall fidelity of the Ukrainian people to the canonical Church led by His Beatitude Metropolitan Onuphry of Kiev and All Ukraine.
