The Feast of the Translation of the Holy Relics of Saint Nektarios at his Monastery in Aegina



On Tuesday, 3 September 2024, with due ecclesiastical splendour, at the Holy Monastery of Saint Nektarios in Aegina, a Poly-Hierarchical Divine Liturgy took place on the occasion of the memory of the translation of the Holy Relics of Saint Nektarios.

The Feast Day Divine Liturgy was presided over by His Eminence Metropolitan leronymos of Kalavryta and Aigialeia, and was joined in concelebration by Their Graces, Bishop Chrysostomos of Bukoba and Western Tanzania, Bishop Epiphanios of Talantio, and the local Shepherd, His Eminence Metropolitan Ephraim of Hydra, Spetses and Aegina.


