

Commemoration of Metropolitan Jonah Lwanga at St.Nicholas Cathedral



With the blessings of Metropolitan Jeronymos of Kampala, Bishop Silvester of Jinja presided over the hierarchical Divine Liturgy and the special memorial service yesterday at St Nicholas Cathedral in remembering three years since the repose of Metropolitan Jonah Lwanga.
