Relatively unknown to the American public but visited by tourists from all over the world, the [Holy Trinity Orthodox Cathedral](#) located in the heart of the historic Ukrainian Village and Wicker Park district in Chicago is a monument that, by its exceptional beauty, impresses its visitors whether they are passionate about architecture or religious art, or visitors in spiritual quest. With the impetus of many Russian, Ukrainian, Greek, Serb and Bulgarian immigrants, the parish of St. Vladimir was renamed Church of the Holy Trinity in 1892 and had the honor of being the first Orthodox community in Chicago.
