

Romanian Orthodox Church to mark Patriarch Daniel's 17th enthronement anniversary

On Monday, September 30, 2024, the Romanian Orthodox Church will mark the 17th anniversary of the enthronement of His Beatitude Patriarch Daniel.

The program begins with the Divine Liturgy at the Patriarchal Cathedral from 9:00 to 11:00 AM.

Following the liturgy, at 11:00 AM, a Te Deum service will be held in the Cathedral as thanksgiving to God for the blessings bestowed upon the Romanian Orthodox Church and His Beatitude Patriarch Daniel during 17 years of fruitful patriarchal ministry.

A festive event will take place at noon in the Europa Christiana Hall of the Patriarchal Palace, attended by the Romanian Patriarchate's official guests, including:

- Members of the Holy Synod;
- The State Secretary for Religious Affairs;
- Leaders of official religious denominations in Romania;
- Members of the Standing National Church Council and the Standing Diocesan Council of the Bucharest Archdiocese. Access to the event will be by invitation only.
