The Relics of St Nektarios the Wonderworker at the Archdiocesan Chapel



On the evening of Monday, 4 November 2024, with the blessing and encouragement of His Eminence Archbishop Nikitas of Thyateira and Great Britain, a delegation of parishioners from the Church of St Nektarios in Battersea, London, led by their clergy, the Revd Protopresbyter Christodoulos Christodoulou and the Revd Stephen Morys Ireland, accompanied the grace-filled relics of St Nektarios the Wonderworker to the Archdiocesan Headquarters.
