



Parochial Schoolchildren Light Archdiocese Christmas Tree alongside Archbishop Elpidophoros



Greek Orthodox parochial school students gathered to help welcome the Christmas season to the Archdiocese Headquarters in New York, New York.



Arriving from four of the city's boroughs, the children represented five New York


