He was indeed a great hierarch and a great man, who accomplished a unique work in Albania, essentially reestablishing a destroyed Church, but first and foremost he was a man of God who cared about people. That is why I will have the opportunity, we will be together at the funeral service in

Tirana to honour him as he deserves.

“He was truly a man of the few,” said Archbishop Ieronymos for his part and continued: “I also knew him and was with him since the 3rd grade of high school. May God rest his soul. We thank you for your participation in our mourning and sorrow.”
