Kalamata: Grand celebration of the feast of "Panagia Ypapanti" and procession of the miraculous Icon



With due ecclesiastical splendour, devotion and the presence of thousands of faithful believers, the city of Kalamata celebrated the feast of its patroness, "Panagia Ypapanti", at the city's celebrating Metropolitan Church.
