

Melbourne: Feast Day of the Church of Saint Haralambos, Templestowe



The parish of St. Haralambos in Templestowe marked the Patronal Feast of their beloved patron saint with services on Sunday, February 9th, and Monday, February 10th. His Grace Bishop Kyriakos of Melbourne presided over the celebrations, which included Vespers, Matins, and the Hierarchical Divine Liturgy.

On Sunday evening, the faithful gathered for the Vespereal service, with His Grace Bishop Kyriakos of Melbourne and several priests from the Diocese of Melbourne leading the prayers. The atmosphere was one of devotion as the congregation prepared for the feast day.

The next morning, the faithful attended Matins and the Hierarchical Divine Liturgy.
