Bishop Ioan Casian visits Assumption University in Canada for future collaboration



On Tuesday, His Grace Bishop Ioan Casian of Canada visited Assumption University, a Catholic institution in Windsor, Ontario, to discuss potential collaborations and partnerships in light of the 1700th anniversary of the First Ecumenical Council of Nicaea.

During his meeting with John Cappucci, President of Assumption University, the two discussed global Christianity and the challenges Christians face in Canada.

At the end of the visit, President Cappucci introduced Bishop Ioan Casian to the university's faculty and presented him with a copy of Pope Francis' encyclical letter "Laudato Si".
