

Diplomatic and religious dialogue: Bishop Varlaam meets Georgian Ambassador in Bucharest

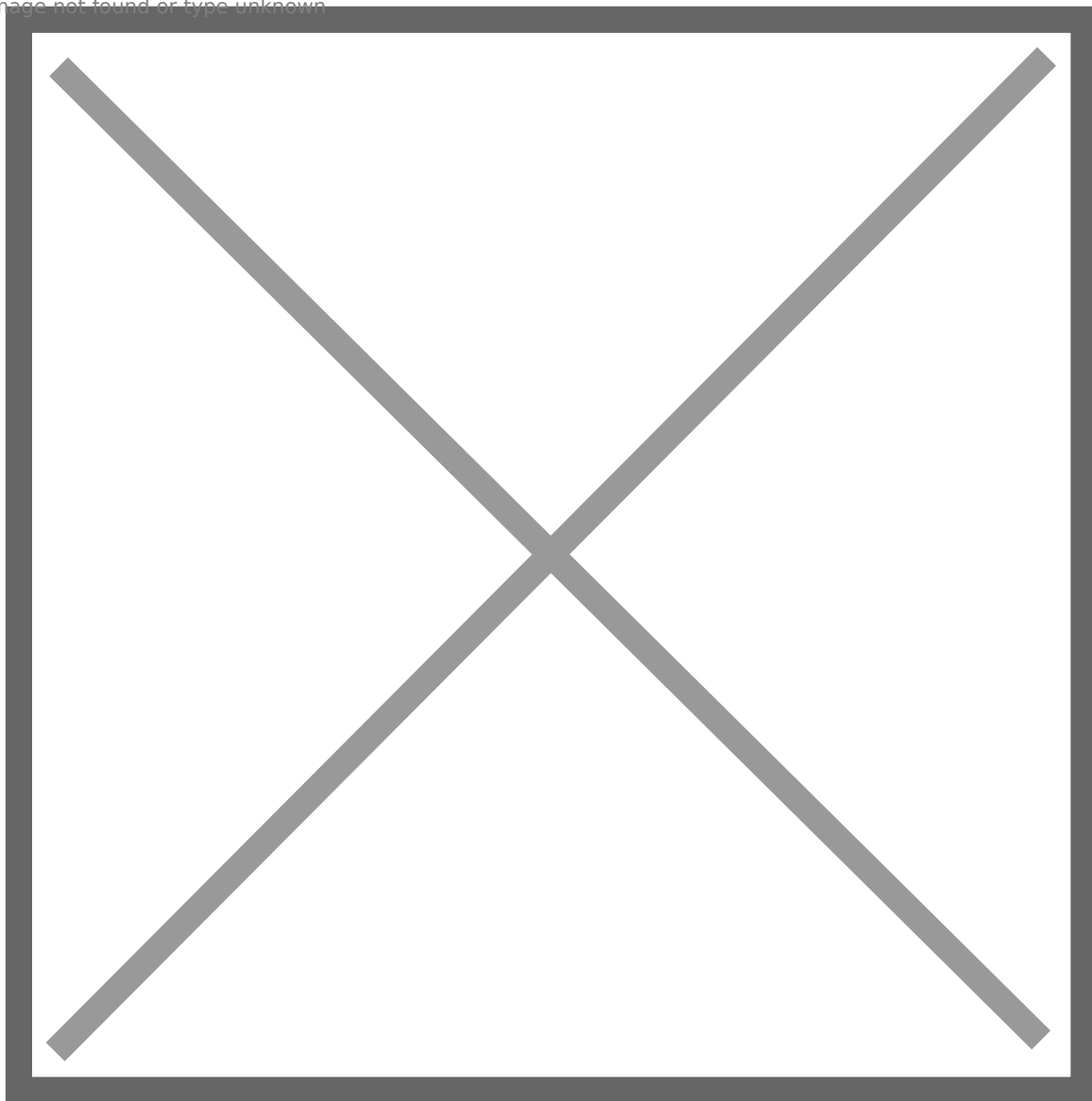


On Wednesday, His Grace Patriarchal Auxiliary Bishop Varlaam of Ploiești, Secretary of the Holy Synod, welcomed Her Excellency Tamar Beruchashvili, Ambassador of Georgia to Romania, at the Patriarchal Palace in Bucharest.

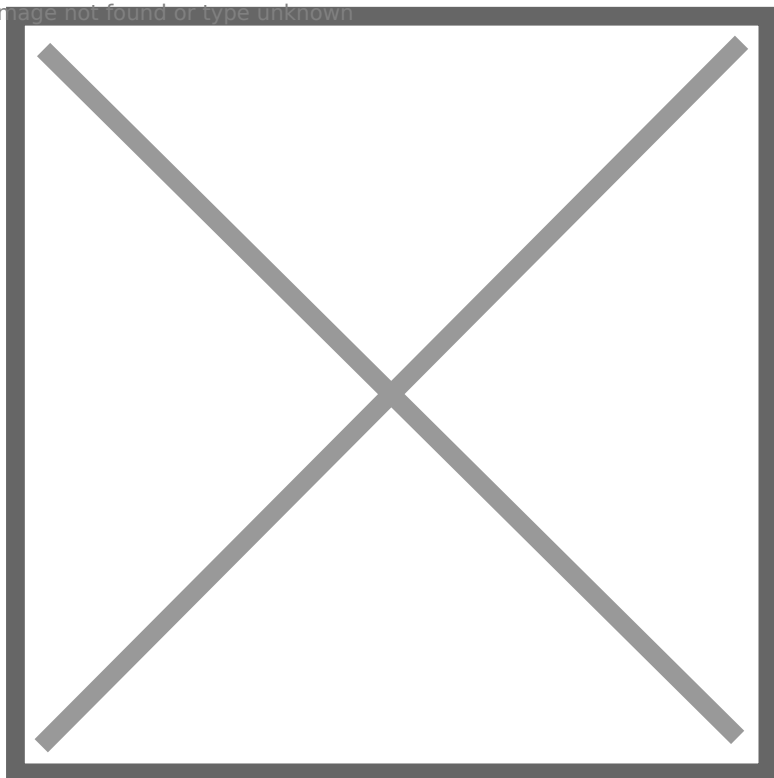
