Subsequently, His All-Holiness the Patriarch will confer on Mr. Spyridon Divanis, from Athens, the title of Archon of the Holy Great Church of Christ.

The following day, Sunday, the 9th of the same month, His All-Holiness will preside

over the established Patriarchal and Synodal Divine Liturgy, in concelebration with His Beatitude.

After the dismissal, the customary Trisagion memorial service will be celebrated for the repose of the souls of those who fought for our Orthodox faith and were perfected in it, and the procession of the holy icons will follow by the Patriarch, His Beatitude, and the holy Hierarchs who will be concelebrating with them.
