

Fourth Sunday of Lent in Haringey



On Sunday 30th March 2025, the Fourth Sunday of Lent (St John Climacus), His Eminence Archbishop Nikitas of Thyateira and Great Britain celebrated the Divine Liturgy at the Church of St John the Baptist in Haringey, North London. Concelebrating with His Eminence were the Very Revd Archimandrite Apostolos Trifyllis and the Revd Presbyter Konstantinos Mamouris, while the Revd Archdeacon George Tsourous and the Revd Deacon Georgios Ntallas also served at the Holy Altar.

At the conclusion of the Divine Liturgy, His Eminence elevated David Dochitciu Barau and Alexandru Cotro to the Order of Readers. In conferring this honour, he emphasised the sacred responsibility entrusted to Readers within the Church, calling them to serve with humility, reverence, and devotion to the liturgical life of the Christian community.

Immediately following the Liturgy, the Annual Memorial Service was held in honour of the victims of the 1974 invasion of Cyprus, and of all those who gave their lives for the freedom of Cyprus and Greece throughout history. The service was attended by His Excellency Kyriacos Kouros, High Commissioner of the Republic of Cyprus to the United Kingdom, and Mr Christos Karaolis, President of the National Federation of Cypriots in the UK. Both dignitaries addressed the congregation,

offering words of reflection, remembrance, and enduring hope for justice and reconciliation.

The day concluded with a festal meal in the Community Hall, where clergy, faithful, and guests shared in fellowship, united in faith, remembrance, and gratitude for the blessings of the day.
