Construction of Holy Trinity church in Argentina is in progress



The church of Holy Trinity in the town of Resistencia, which construction was began by the youngest diocese of the Serbian Orthodox Church, Diocese of Buenos Aires and South-Central America, upon the blessing of then Administrator of the Diocese Metropolitan Amfilohije, has been getting its shape.

The decree on the allotment of land for the construction of the Church of the Holy Trinity was signed by the Governor of the Province Mr. Domingo Pepo just over a year ago to the general satisfaction of the numerous descendants of expatriates from Montenegro and Serbia, as well as as well as of the associations that bring together descendants of the Greeks, Ukrainians, Russians, Bulgarians, and Antiochians.
