Metropolis of San Francisco Clergy-Laity Assembly Convenes



The 2025 Clergy-Laity Assembly for the Greek Orthodox Metropolis of San Francisco convened on May 5 at Saint Nicholas Ranch and Retreat Center in Dunlap, CA. The theme of the Assembly focused on "Our Faith Can Move Mountains".

The Assembly began with an opening prayer service led by His Eminence Archbishop Elpidophoros of America, who also offered welcoming remarks, making special note of the 20th Anniversary of His Eminence Metropolitan Gerasimos as shepherd of the Metropolis of San Francisco, presenting him with an engolpion to commemorate this occasion.

Eva Konstantakos, National Director of the Office of Youth and Youth Adult Ministries of the also offered a presentation on the vast array of youth programs and resources available from the Archdiocese. The day concluded with an outdoor dessert reception and Ministry Pavilion where delegates engaged with Metropolis Ministry leaders who shared valuable resources for parishes and faithful, highlighting the diverse and vibrant ministries offered by the Greek Orthodox Metropolis of San Francisco.
