

Pastoral Visit to the Church of All Saints, Camden - Sunday of All Saints



On Sunday, 15th June 2025, His Eminence Archbishop Nikitas of Thyateira and Great Britain visited the Church of All Saints in Camden for the celebration of the parish's patronal feast, marking the Sunday of All Saints.

His Eminence presided at the Divine Liturgy, concelebrating with the Revd Protopresbyter Georgios Zafeirakos, parish priest, and assisted by the Revd Archdeacon George Tsourous. The church was filled with faithful, gathered to honour the cloud of saints who have shone forth in the light of Christ.
