

The Feast Day of Apostle Silas in Mylopotamos, Rethymno



On Tuesday afternoon, 29 July 2025, His Eminence Metropolitan Prodrornos of Rethymno and Avlopotamos, went, for the first time, to the celebrating Church of Apostle Silas in the settlement of the same name of the Parish of Damavolos, Mylopotamos, where he officiated at the Hierarchical Vespers.
