Patriarch Kirill and Archbishop John have a telephone talk



On September 14, 2019, a telephone conversation took place between His Holiness Patriarch Kirill of Moscow and All Rus with Archbishop John (Renneto) of Dubna.

During the telephone conversation on September 14, His Holiness Patriarch Kirill informed Archbishop John (Renneto) that the Holy Synod had decided to satisfy the request of most of the Archdiocese of Western Europe to join the Moscow Patriarchate. Earlier, the UOJ wrote that on September 14, 2019, the Holy Synod of the Russian Orthodox Church resolved to admit Archbishop John (Renneto), as well as all interested clergy and parishes of the Archbishopric of Orthodox Russian Churches in Western Europe to the jurisdiction of the Moscow Patriarchate.
