

Abp. Elpidophoros attends doctoral defense of V. Rev. Arch. Kaisarios Chronis



His Eminence Archbishop Elpidophoros of America participated this morning, via video link, in the successful doctoral defense of V. Rev. Archimandrite Kaisarios Chronis at the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Department of Theology. The dissertation, titled “The Panorthodox Council of Constantinople (1923) and its Historical Context” was met with high praise from the examining committee.

V. Rev. Archimandrite Kaisarios Chronis is a spiritual son of His Eminence. He was ordained by Archbishop Elpidophoros during the Archbishop's tenure as Abbot of the Holy Monastery of Halki. He now serves as the Archivist of the Ecumenical Patriarchate in Constantinople.
