

Synodal Divine Liturgy celebrated at Penteli Monastery on the Feast of Saint Photios



On Friday, 6 February 2026, the feast of Saint Photios, Patriarch of Constantinople, a Synodal Divine Liturgy was celebrated at the katholikon of the Holy Monastery of Penteli, in the presence of His Beatitude Archbishop Ieronymos of Athens and All Greece.

The Divine Liturgy was presided over by the Vice President of the Holy Synod, His Eminence Metropolitan Chrysostomos of Chalkida, concelebrated by His Eminence Metropolitan Nikolaos of Mesogaia and His Eminence Metropolitan Eirinaios of Florina, together with clergy. The Divine Liturgy was held in an atmosphere of reverence and prayer, honouring the memory of the great Patriarch of Constantinople and teacher of the Church, Saint Photios.

Following the Divine Liturgy, a commemorative event was held in honour of the

feast. The keynote address was delivered by Professor Vasiliki Mitropoulou, who spoke on the theme, "The Pedagogical Messages of Saint Photios in the
