

Meetings held by the Ecumenical Patriarch in Athens



On Tuesday, 5 May, Prince Pavlos met with His All-Holiness Ecumenical Patriarch Bartholomew, on the occasion of His All-Holiness' visit to Greece.

Prince Pavlos wrote characteristically about his meeting with the Ecumenical Patriarch in a post:

“Today I had the special honour and blessing to meet our Ecumenical Patriarch, His All-Holiness Bartholomew, shortly before his appearance in Parliament for his historic address. His presence and his words are a constant source of inspiration, wisdom, and spiritual guidance, reminding us all of the importance of global dialogue, unity, and the values that unite us. In a time of challenges and uncertainty, I hold as a precious legacy the message of peace and understanding, which today more than ever we need.”
