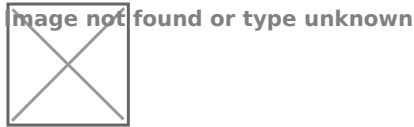


The Ecumenical Patriarch attended a Scholarly Symposium on Symeon Siniosoglou in Constantinople (Video)

The speakers were:

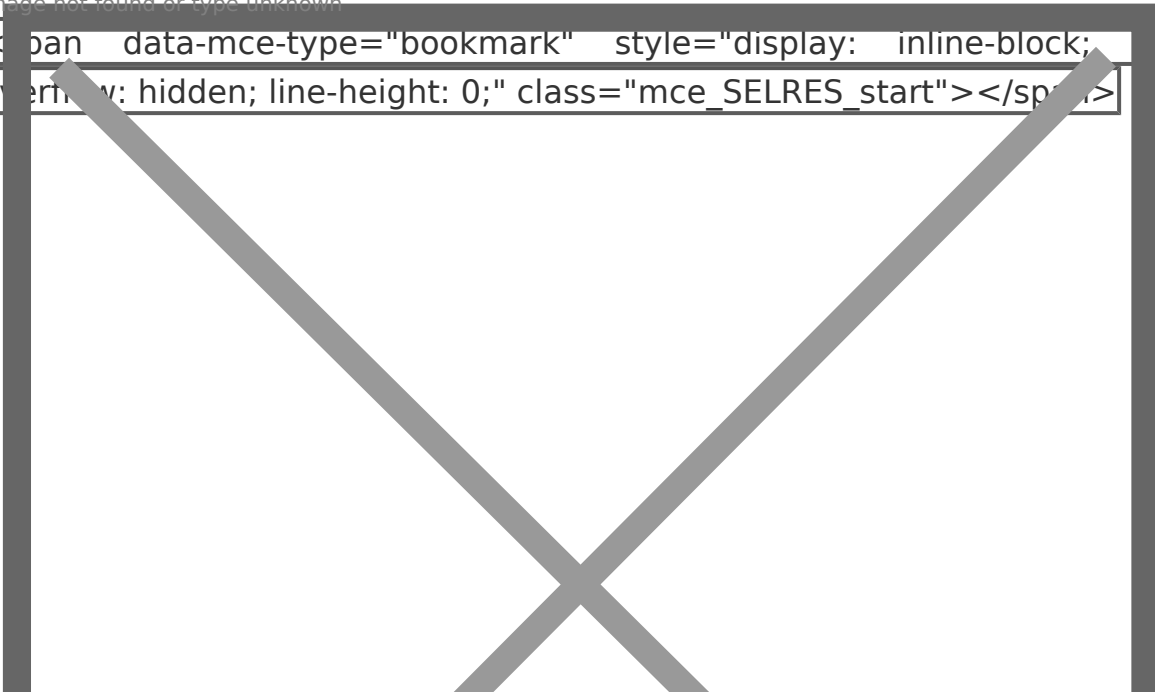
