

Archbishop Makarios of Australia arrives in the ‘City of Churches’

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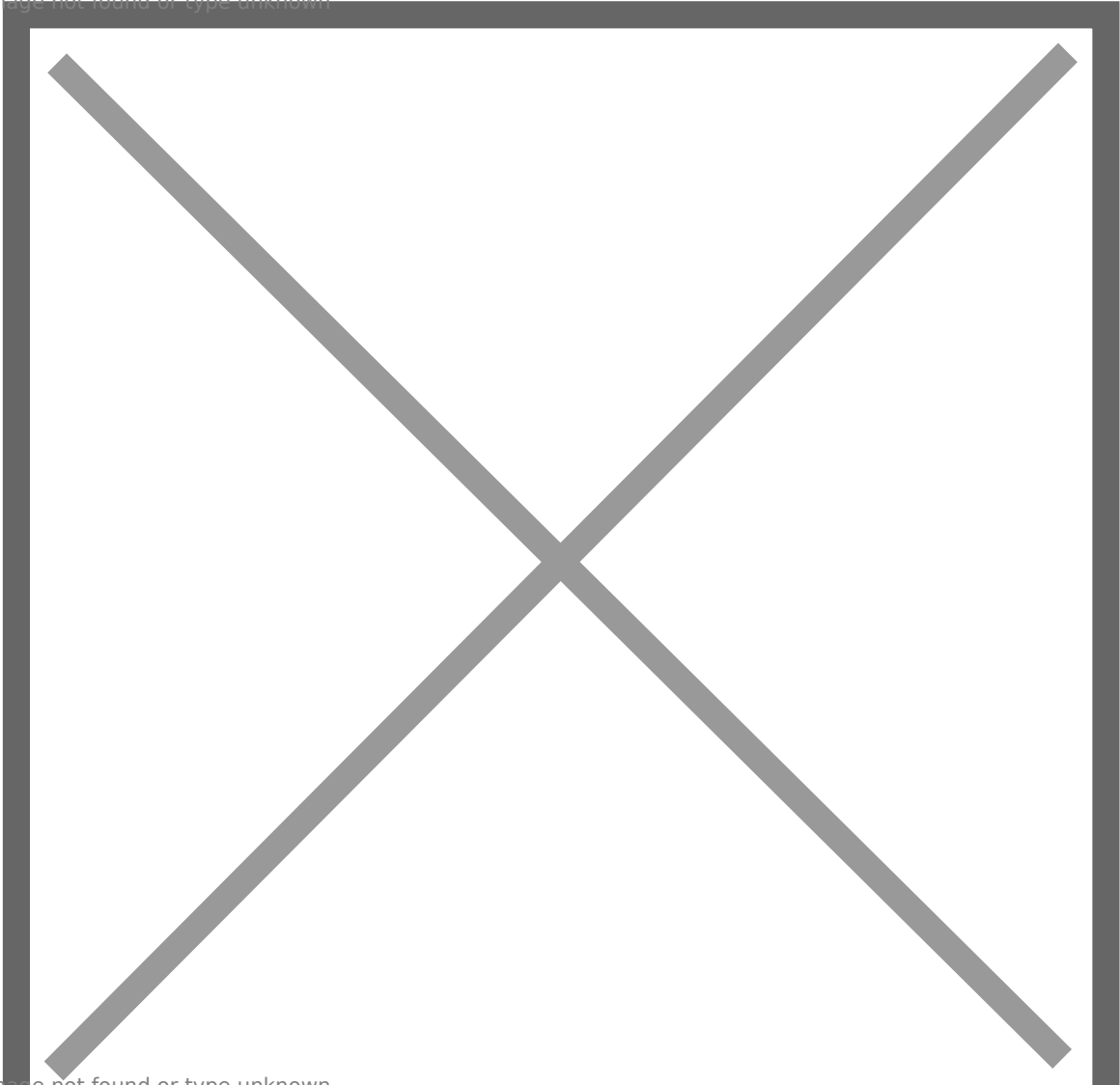

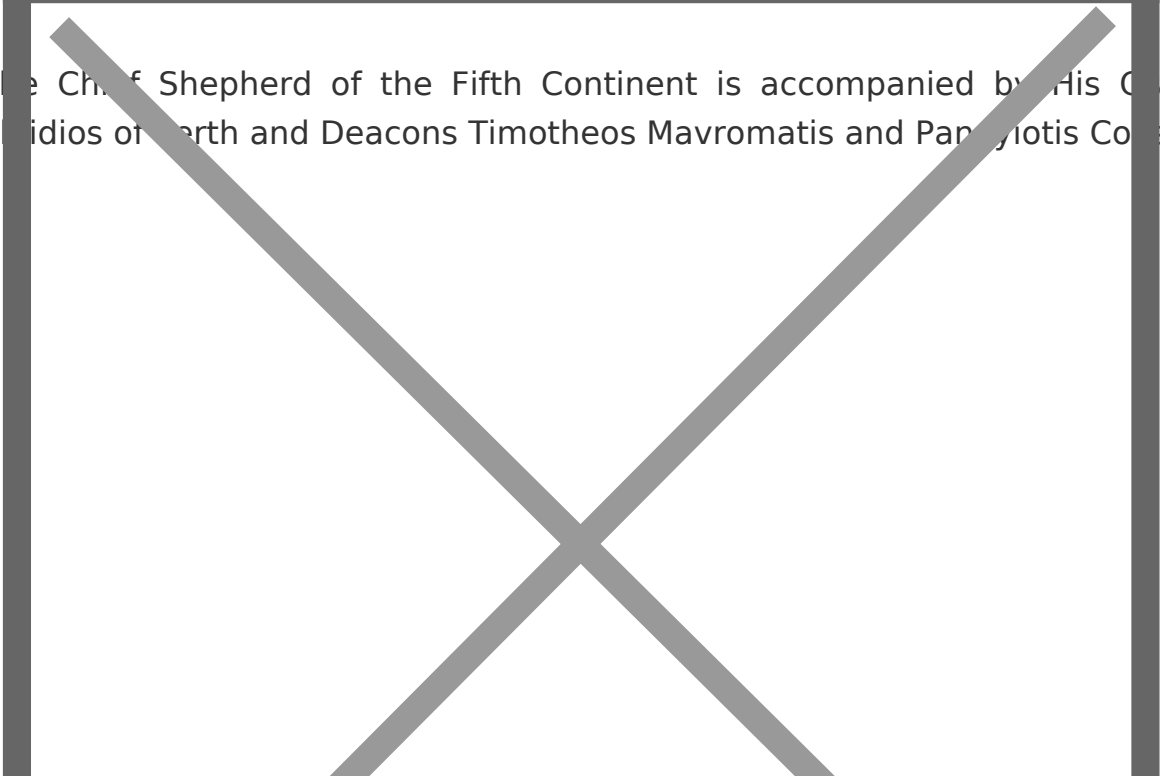


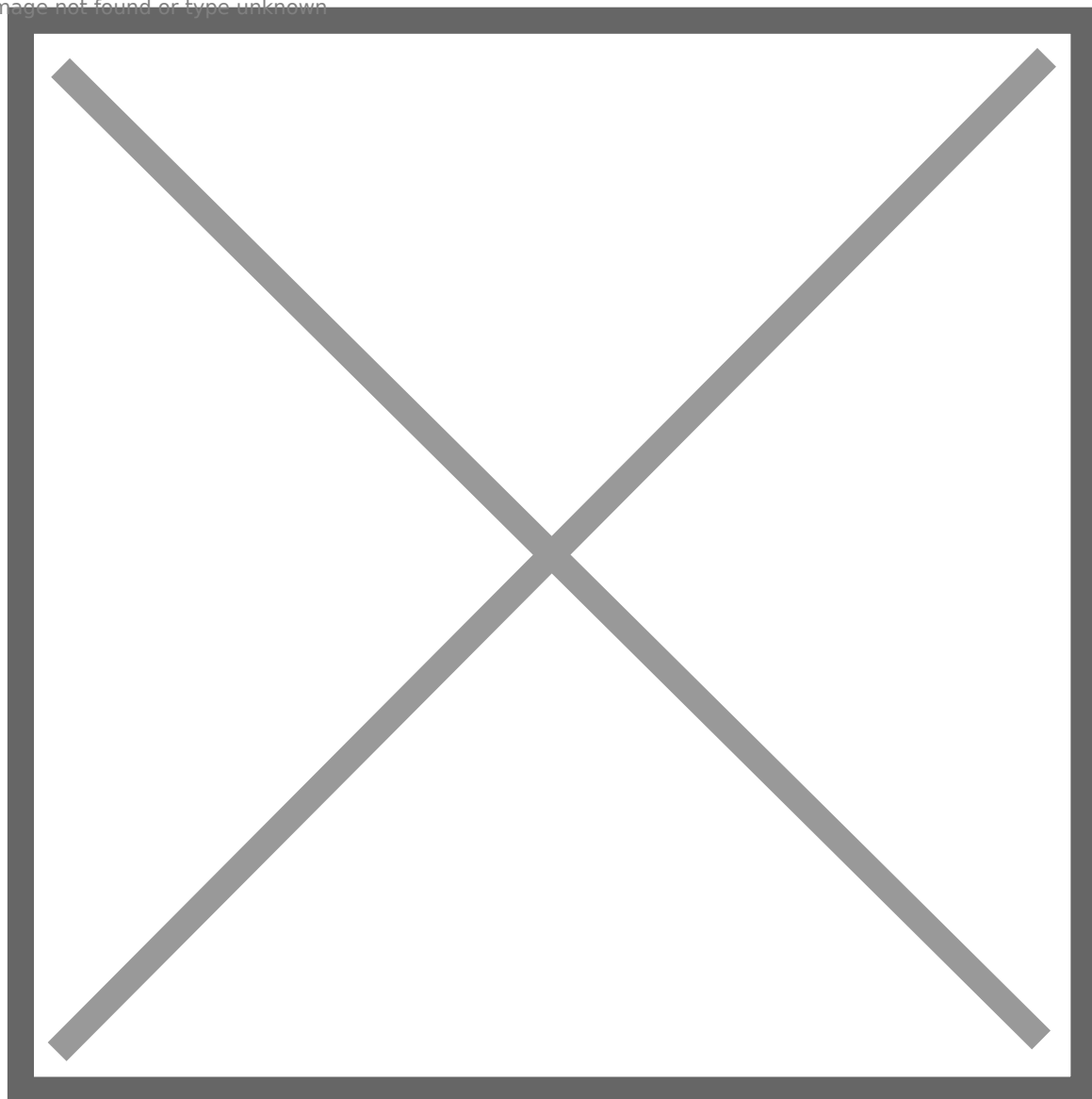








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
