The Elder Archimandrite Ephraim, the Abbot of the Holy and Great Monastery of Vatopedi, on Wednesday gave a lecture entitled "Let Everything That Has Breath Praise the Lord" (Psalm 150:6), at the St. (Aghios) Demetrius Cathedral in southeast Athens.
