Wreath-laying and other festivities followed at the church's courtyard.

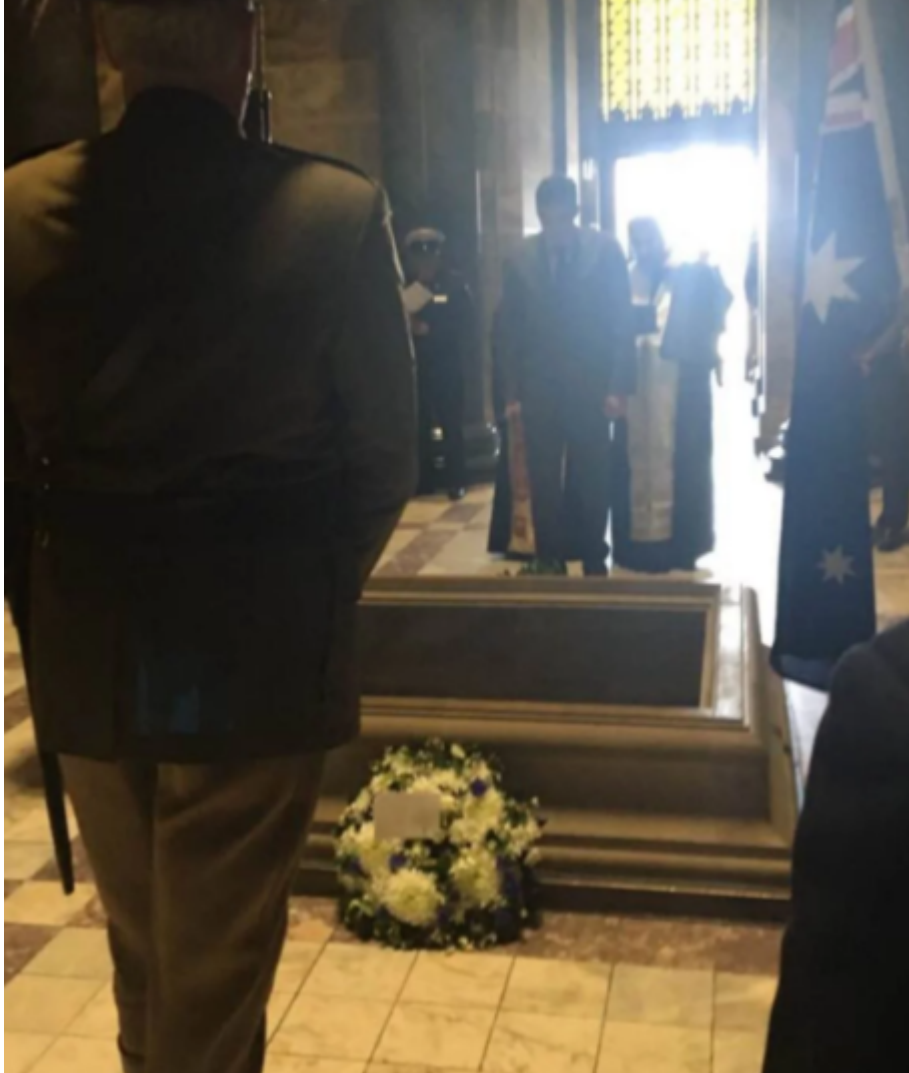
