Ecumenical Patriarch receives Greek Parliament delegation



The Ecumenical Patriarch of Constantinople, His All Holiness Bartholomew I, on Thursday received a delegation of Greek Parliament deputies who are members of the Diaspora and Hellenism committee in the legislature.

The president of the committee, Savvas Anastasiadis, expressed his and the other members' respect for the venerable Church of Constantinople, while briefing the Ecumenical Patriarch over the committee's work.
