

Greek Dept. FM resigns



Greek Deputy Foreign Minister Antonis Diamataris on Thursday tendered his resignation, which was accepted by Prime Minister Kyriakos Mitsotakis.

In a resignation letter, Diamataris, who held the Greek Diaspora and religious diplomacy portfolio, said that over the past few days he was the recipient of **"...personal attacks aimed to disorient, with the purpose being to damage the (Greek) government and the prime minister, which I love and hold in esteem, as well as to undermine my work"**.

Questions arose over the past week over the academic degrees listed on Diamataris' resume.
