

Russian Patriarch receives visiting Moldova president in Moscow



The Patriarch of Moscow and All Russia, His Holiness Kirill, on Thursday received the visiting President of Moldova, Igor Dodon. The meeting was attended by ambassador of Moldova to the Russian federation, Andrei Neguta, and the chairman of the Moscow Patriarchate's Department for Church's Society and Mass Media Relations, Vladimir Legoida.
