Patriarch of Alexandria in exclusive interview with Orthodoxia news agency



The Patriarch of Alexandria and All Africa, His Divine Beatitude Theodoros II, spoke to the Orthodoxia news agency and journalist Maria Giachnaki this month, in an exclusive interview, where he details the Patriarchate's difficult but fruitful missionary work in Africa.

His Divine Beatitude also spoke about peace in the troubled Middle East and the continuing persecution of Christians in its ancient lands, as well as efforts to combat poverty.

The Patriarch of Alexandria fondly spoke about Crete, his native island, while he was asked about the contentious issue of Autocephaly for the Ukrainian Orthodox Church and the position expressed by the Holy Synod of the Alexandria Patriarchate on the issue.
