Celebrating Greek Orthodox Education and the Feast of Ypapanti in British Columbia in the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of Canada

On January 29th, His Eminence presided at Great Vespers of the Three Hierarchs at Saint Nicholas and Demetrios Greek Orthodox Church in East Vancouver, assisted by the clergy of Metro Vancouver. After the service, the celebration of Greek Orthodox education took place, with the students of the various Greek schools reciting their poems. Archbishop Sotirios celebrated the Divine Liturgy on Sunday, February 2nd at St. George Greek Orthodox Cathedral in Vancouver, assisted by Fr. O. Drossos, Parish priest, Fr. G. Despotov, and Fr. D. Tryphonopoulos. Fr. D. Partsafas, former Parish priest of the cathedral, was in attendance and prayed at the service.
