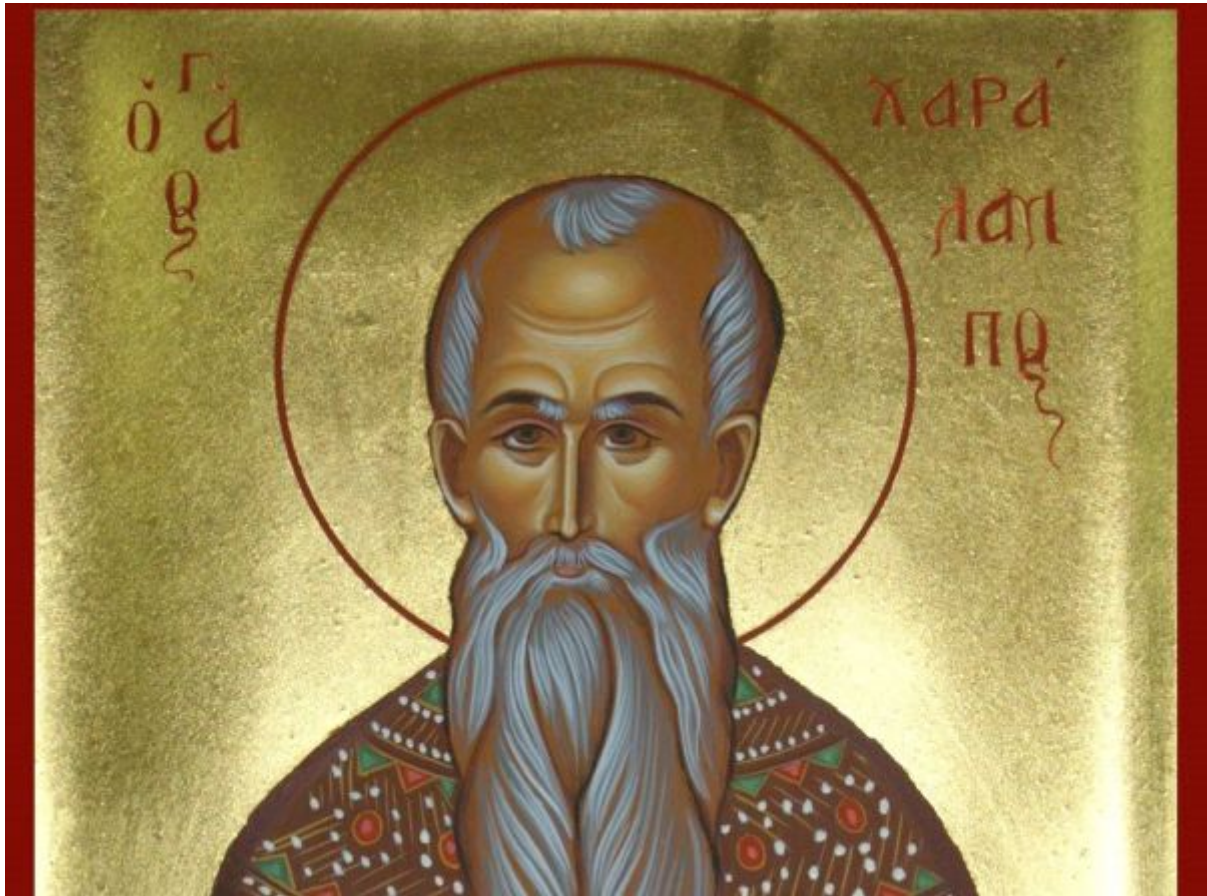


Church today venerates memory of Hieromartyr Haralambos
