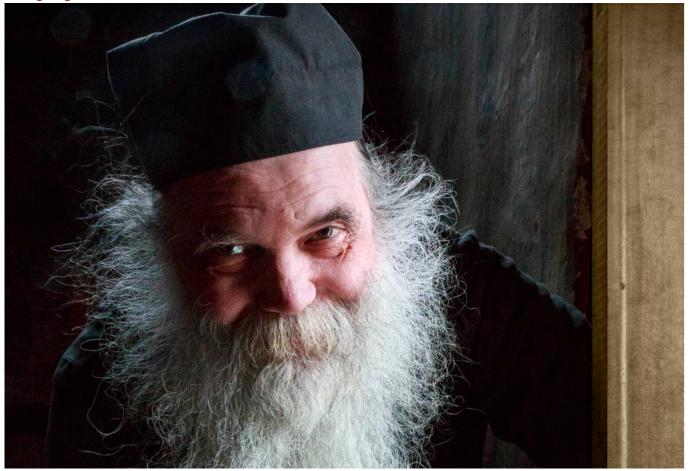
Enjoy the Silence
