Metropolitan of Nea Ionia & Philadelphia: State ban on partaking of Holy Communion extreme, but possibly necessary



The Autocephalous Church of Greece's Metropolitan of Nea Ionia and Philadelphia, His Eminence Gabriel, spoke this week to the Orthodoxia news agency, underlining that without the Holy Eucharist there is no Church. At the same time, His Eminence acknowledged that the state's ban on the partaking of Holy Communion was extreme, but possibly necessary. Gabriel said "...we all have a responsibility to safeguard God's gifts".
