The tour includes, of course, the holy Edicule, which is the chapel above the Lord's Tomb itself, the place of Golgotha where the Lord was crucified, the stone on which

His Most Pure Body was laid when they took Him down from the Cross, the Chapel of Adam, where our first-formed ancestor was buried, the Chapel of St. Helen, the Church of St. Jacob, and much more.
