Meals and foodstuffs are being delivered to the elderly on the islands, with the assistance of the local Orthodox parishes and pupils.

The Turkish state has restricted the movement of people above the age of 65 in public spaces, part of restrictions against the Covid-19 pandemic. As a result, many senior citizens in villages and isolated areas are facing difficulties in acquiring



groceries.
