

Romanian Patriarchate offers 470,000-Euros worth of aid between April 20 and 27, 2020



The Romanian Patriarchate has announced that the amount of aid offered by the Church to the fight against the coronavirus pandemic exceeded 470,000 Euros (2,278,396 Lei) in the week of April 20-27. That brings the total aid offered by dioceses since the beginning of the health crisis to 3,080,015 Euros (14,876,474 Lei).

The diocesan centers, deaneries, parishes and monasteries of the Romanian

Orthodox Church offered financial and material aid in value of 470,000 Euros (2,278,396 Lei) between April 20 and 27, 2020.
