

Valuable donation from the Diocese of Banja Luka in the fight against the virus



The Diocese of Banja Luka, headed by His Grace Jefrem, Bishop of Banja Luka, has donated 12 500 special professional protective masks to the University Clinical Center of Republika Srpska worth 100.000 Bosnian marks to contribute to the fight against the coronary virus.

The executive director of the University Clinical Centre of the Republic Srpska Dr. Vlado Dajic expressed his gratitude to the Diocese of Banja Luka for a very valuable donation, pointing out that the Serbian Orthodox Church had shown that it is constantly with their people even in the most difficult times.

The personal secretary of Bishop Jefrem, protodeacon Radojica Zagran, said that the donation from the Serbian Orthodox Church had been initiated by Bishop Jefrem in consultation with the management of the University Clinical Centre and their current needs for fighting against coronary virus. The protodeacon pointed out that the Diocese of Banja Luka also paid 72,000 Bosnian marks to the Solidarity Fund of the Republic Srpska as a token of support of the people and the Government of that Republic in the fight against the pandemic of corona virus.
