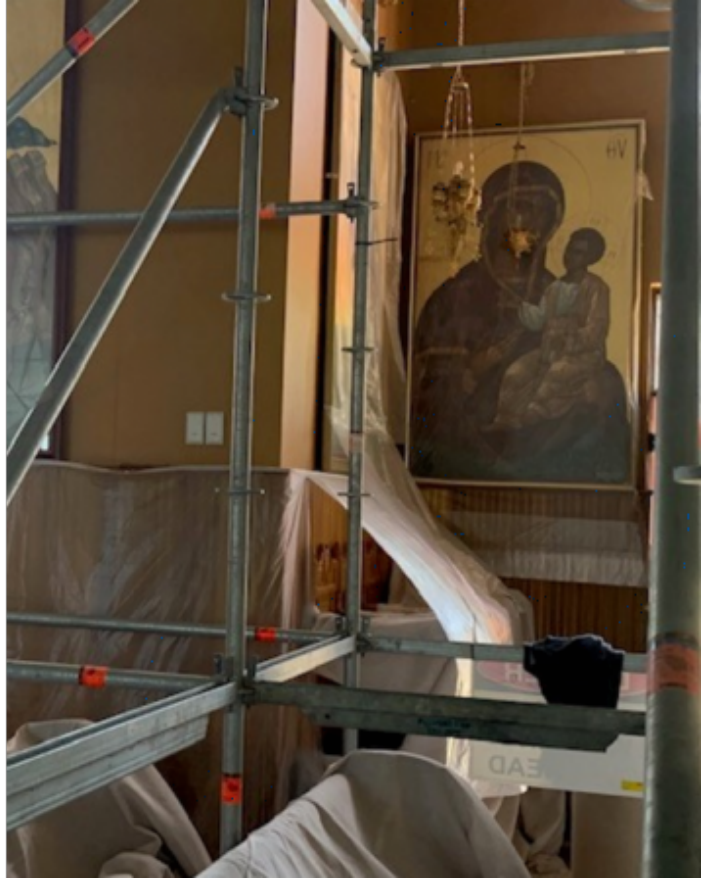
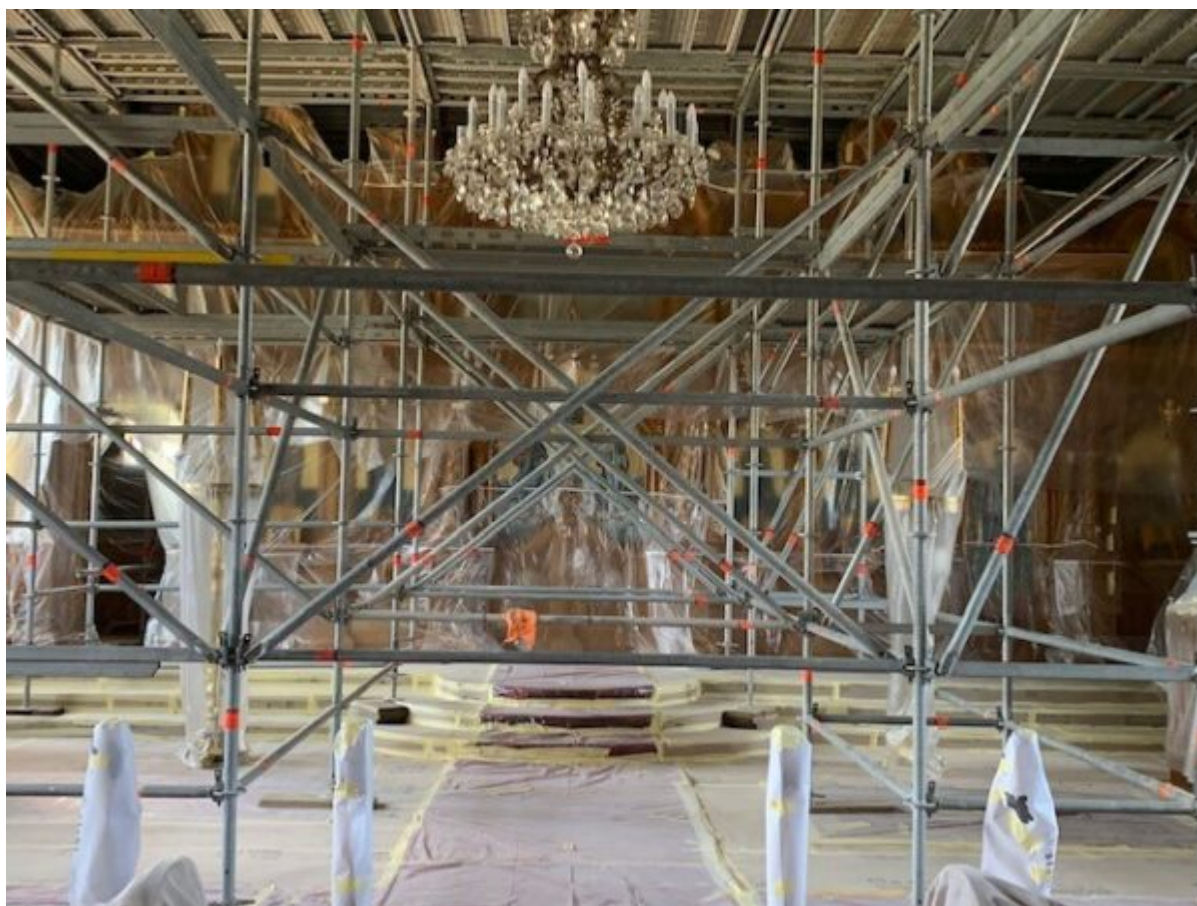

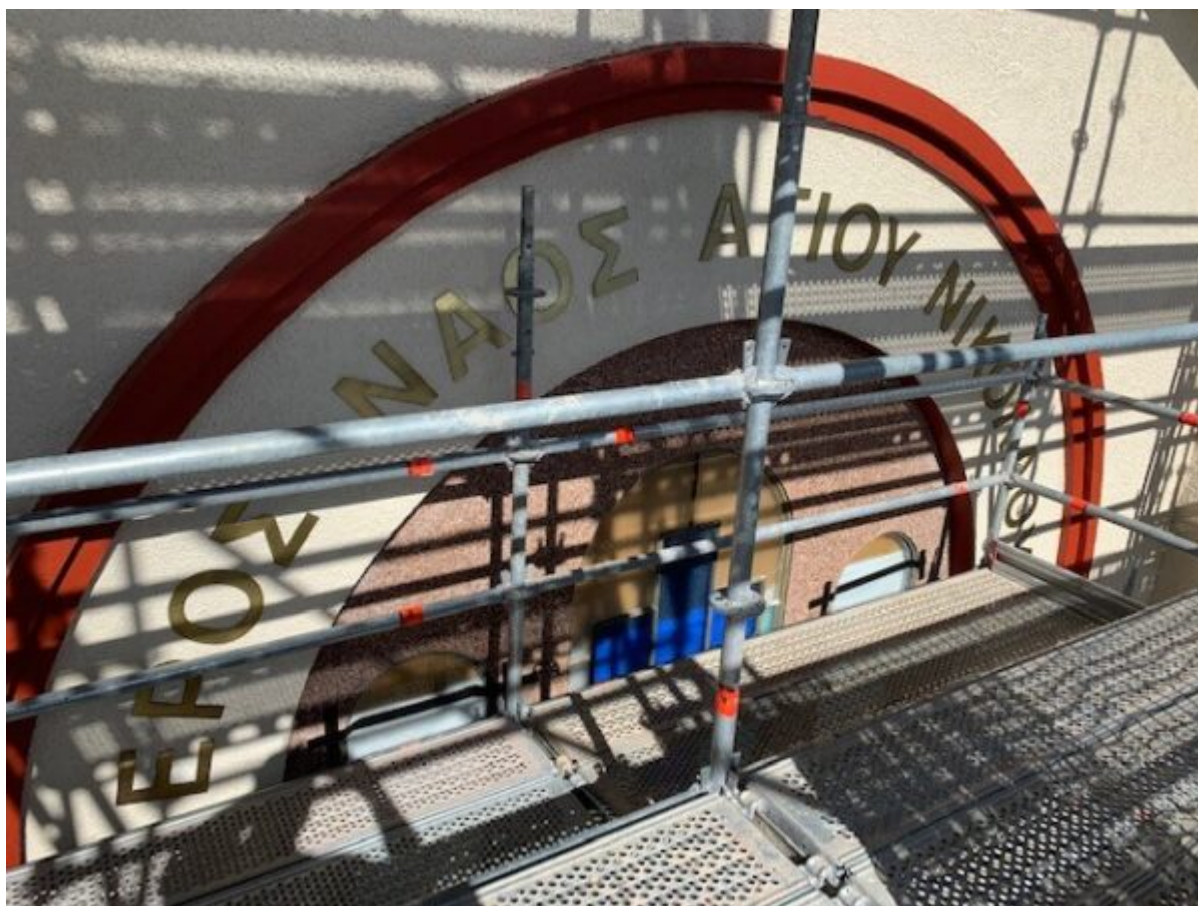
Greek community in Canberra restores hail-damaged church
