Thus he pushed himself in tremendous ascetic feats, in unceasing prayer and intense fasting, finally purifying his soul of the passions after many years and acquiring a state of great grace.

Despite his body remaining always black, his soul nevertheless shined all white, to the extent that Christ Himself once visited him, something that happens only to exceedingly saintly souls. We highly esteem this great saint because he repented of great sins and succeeded in his monastic life, attaining to a high, unimitable level of union with God.

The following story in his life proves all this, “Having succeeded in his monastic life after many years, he became the Father and the spiritual guide of 500 brothers, who elected him to be ordained a priest. When he came before the Patriarch to be ordained, the patriarch wanted to test him by asking the elders, Who brought this black here? Cast him out. He obeyed, and left saying to himself, It is good what they have done to you, O black colored one. The Patriarch, however, called him back and ordained him a priest, and said to him, Moses, all of you now has become

white”
