

Church dedication feast of the Vozdovac church celebrated with the Patriarchal Liturgy

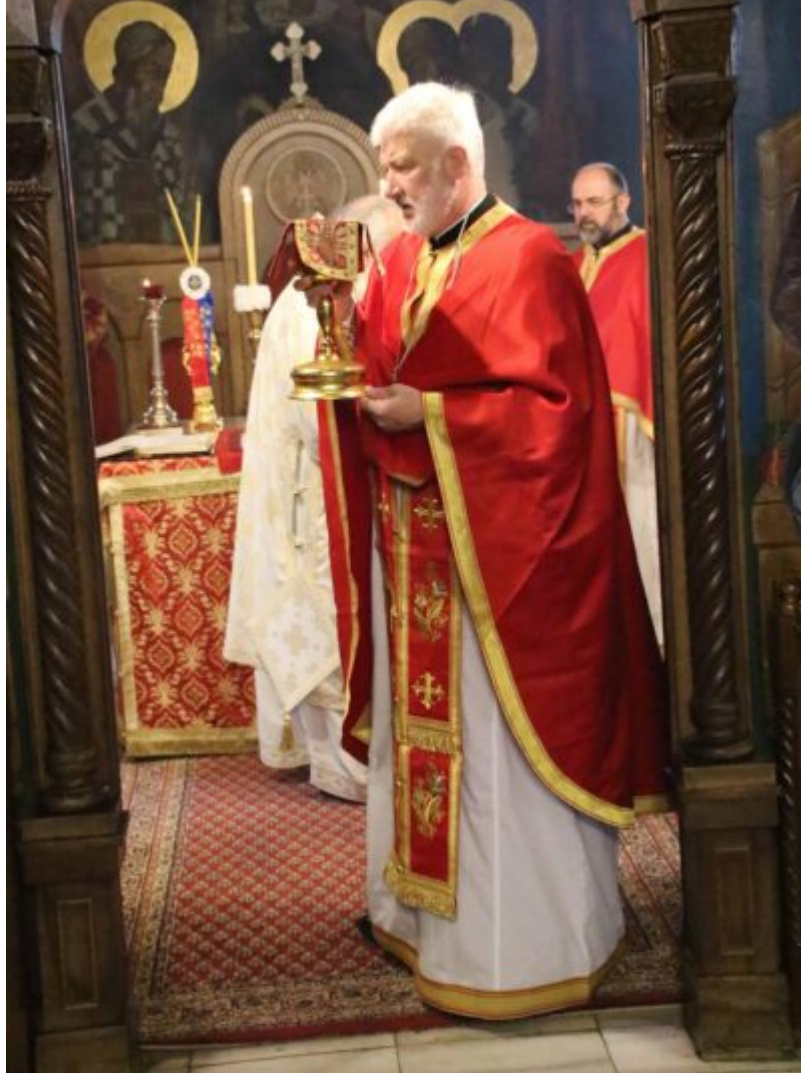
