Archim. Michael (Anischenko) appointed head of Phanar stauropegion in Kiev



The Holy Synod of the Ecumenical Patriarchate appointed the head of the restored Kiev stauropegion.

Archimandrite Michael (Anischenko) was appointed the head of the Constantinople Patriarchate's stauropegion in Kiev, <u>reports the Greek edition of "Orthodoxia News Agency"</u>, referring to the communique of the meeting of the Synod of Constantinople Church, held from 9 to 11 January.

Before then, Archimandrite Michael (Anischenko) was the abbot of the Orthodox Church of St. Alypius the Stylite of the Ecumenical Patriarchate in Antalya. For a long time, he served in Lutsk and was a cleric of the UOC metropolitan cathedral of the Volyn eparchy. Also, Archimandrite Michael was considered as a candidate for the post of head of the Archdiocese of Russian Orthodox churches in Western Europe.
